CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S ORDER NO. 14 OF 2002

AN

ORDER

to amend the Conduct of General Elections Order, 2002

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Conduct of General Elections Order, 2002 (Chief Executive's Order No. 7 of 2002), for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of Emergency of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Chief Executive of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan is pleased to make and promulgate the following Order :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Order may be called the Conduct of General Elections (Amendment) Order, 2002.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Insertion of new Article 7A, Chief Executive's Order No. 7 of 2002.**—In the Conduct of General Elections Order, 2002 (Chief Executive's Order No. 7 of 2002), after Article 7, the following new Article shall be inserted, namely :—

“7A. **Age of voters.**—Notwithstanding anything contained in the Constitution or any other law for the time being in force including the Electoral Rolls Act, 1974 (XXI of 1974), for the election of members of the National Assembly and Provincial Assemblies, a citizen who has attained the age of eighteen years on the first day of January, 2002, shall be eligible to vote and the Chief Election Commissioner shall cause the electoral rolls to be prepared accordingly under the provisions of the Electoral Rolls Act, 1974 :

Provided that any claim for inclusion of any name or objection against any entry in the electoral roll shall be made to the Revising Authority within 15 days of the publication of the draft electoral roll.”
